Purpose

To state the elements of, and define, what constitutes the Stella Maris Catholic Primary School Special Character

- 1. To bring together all facets of school life in the light of Catholic belief and tradition.
- 2. To nurture and encourage a Christian way of life in all members of the Stella Maris community
- 3. To provide opportunities for the pupils to learn about the beliefs of the Catholic Church through a systematic and structured course using the Religious Education Programme endorsed by the New Zealand Catholic Bishops.
- 4. To instil a sense of pride in the traditions and heritage of the Catholic Church through encouragement to participate in the life and worship of parish and school.
- **5.** To promote the integration of our Special Character in all curriculum areas.
- **6.** Promote professional development in Religious Education and Special Character.
- 7. Encourage teachers to gain accreditation levels in Religious Education.
