This Sunday the Gospel starts with a private conversation. Here we find Jesus in a Samaritan city. Jacob's well was there, and it is here that Jesus speaks of living water to a Samaritan woman. Jesus ask the woman for a drink which was not something a Jew would ask of a Samaritan woman. When she questions Him about asking her for water, He tells her that he is the "Living Water." Jesus tells her, "Whoever drinks of this water will thirst again, but whoever drinks of the water that I shall give him will never thirst. But the water that I shall give him will become in him a fountain of water springing up into everlasting life."

Where does Jesus find us today? Are we feeling like we're on the outside, looking in? Is Jesus calling us to stop going to the same dried up well for joy or relief, and instead drink deeply of the living water that will bring joy and relief eternal? Are there people around us who are thirsty and in need of the hope that comes from the good news of a God who cares and loves and changes lives?
