Whiria te tangata – Weave the people together

#### **PURPOSE**

To follow the three main principles of Tiriti o Waitangi interwoven with our Special Character and faith. These are:

Partnership: to work with whanau, Maori community and iwi, the church and Ministry of Education.

Participation: to include Maori whanau in our school decision making and that our school environment will reflect the biculturalism of Aotearoa.

Protection: will actively protect Maori Knowledge, interests and values and other Taonga, and allow opportunities to weave tikanga into everyday situations.

### PROCEDURES

- 1. Staff will work towards a Curriculum Plan for Taha Maori
- 2. All students have the opportunity to acquire knowledge of te reo Maori and tikanga
- 3. Resources will be provided for staff development to support teachers in implementing the three principles of Tiriti o Waitangi.
- 4. Taha wairua and pastoral care will be provided through culturally appropriate ways.
- 5. Adding Maori perspective to concepts and inquiry.
- 6. Incorporating Maori values alongside our Marian values reflecting our unique culture and identity.
