POLICY: EQUAL EDUCATIONAL OPPORTUNITY

"Ehara taku toa I te toa takitahi engari he to takimano." My strength is not that of an individual but that of the collective.

PURPOSE

- 1. To develop and implement special learning programmes for students identified as having divergent learning requirement/needs.
- 2. To ensure that equal opportunities are given to students of all genders in every curriculum area
- 3. To develop cultural awareness in the students and recognise the need of Maori, Pasifika and other ethnic groups to feel proud of their heritage
- 4. To allow for the inclusion of physically disabled students in all school activities
- 5. To ensure that no student will be excluded by socio-economic circumstances from participation in school activities

PROCEDURES

- 1. Students with divergent learning needs will be identified termly, and programmes to cater for these children will be implemented
- 2. Staff will review special learning programmes annually and the Principal will report progress to the Board
- 3. All genders will have equal access to the New Zealand curriculum, school resources and equipment
- 4 Opportunities will be given for students from all ethnic groups to celebrate and share their cultures
- 5. Students with physical disabilities will receive help as is needed for them to be included in school activities as far as is practicable.
- 6. The school will use available resources to ensure no student is disadvantaged by socio-economic circumstances.
