Welcome back to school for Term 3. I trust you all managed some time for relaxing with your families over the break.

This term our overall concept for inquiry is "Turangawaewae". Throughout this inquiry the students will investigate how places in Aotearoa New Zealand are significant to different people for different reasons, and are used in different ways. They will explore the places they have a sense of belonging and connection with, learning about the features of the whenua, land, and the stories and history of them. The teaching and learning for this inquiry will be led mainly through the new Histories curriculum as the teachers unpack this together, but there will be connections with other areas of the curriculum, including English, Social Sciences, Science, Health and PE, and Religious Education.

The Marian Values that are our main focus this term are:

Wisdom: "This message is Christ, who is the power of God and the wisdom of God. For what seems to be God's foolishness is wiser than human wisdom, and what seems to be God's weakness is stronger than human strength." 1 Corinthians 1:24-25.

Empathy: "Share each other's burdens, and in this way obey the law of Christ." Galatians 6:2.

Compassion: "Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you." Ephesians 4:32.

Reminders about Home/School Communication: If children are unwell during the school day they must speak to their class teacher. The school office staff will contact you should your child need to go home due to illness or injury. Students should not be contacting parents directly through email, or messaging on phones or watches as this causes confusion for all involved.

We ask also that any bus changes that occur during the school day are communicated to the school office so that we can be sure the students receive them. Please do not contact your child through text or email directly during the school day as there have been some upset children who have not seen messages which have then led to confusion about catching the buses or not.

We look forward to sharing term 3 with you all.




