It is a time when we recall the origins of the Catholic Church here in our country, when Bishop Pompallier, as he celebrated the first Mass on New Zealand soil, dedicated this mission to the Assumption of Mary. At Stella Maris we too have adopted the Feast of the Assumption as our Feast Day. On this day we remember that Mary is the 'first disciple' of Jesus, and that she walks with us and before us in our own path of Christian discipleship. Our Marian Values are a daily reminder of how Mary models for us how we to can follow in Jesus' footsteps.
