Last week's Goal Setting Conferences via Zoom were a great success. I would like to thank all parents, students and teachers who put a lot of effort into ensuring the students are ready for the next steps in their learning journey.

On Monday 4th April at 11:59pm the changes related to vaccine passes and the vaccine mandate for those in education take effect. At this stage we are still in the Red Phase so all other health measures we have in place remain. As we are so close to the end of the term these health measures will remain in place until the last day of term – this will save the children having to learn new routines for a short time, and then potentially having to adjust to new routines again at the beginning of next term.


