On Monday 15th August we celebrate our School Feast Day, the Assumption of Mary. On November 1, 1950 Pope Pius XII infallibly declared the doctrine of the Assumption a dogma; "that Mary, having completed the course of her earthly life, was assumed body and soul into heavenly glory". While many debate whether she was sleeping or had died Pope Pius left this question open. The dogma deliberately avoids defining this. Pope Pius XII hoped that by reflecting on Mary's Assumption we would learn a deeper respect for our own lives, bodies and those of others.


