During their visit, the team visited every classroom and met with staff, students, the Board and parents, and saw how our Special Character is so very much at the heart of all that we do at Stella Maris, and how we 'Shine for God'. We will receive a full report from the team in a few weeks' time.

A reminder that if your child needs to be at school earlier than 8am you need to book them into the sKids before school programme. There has been an increasing number of children arriving at school before 8am and it is important to note that they are unsupervised before this time.


#### **Annual North Shore Rosary Procession**
