At our Teacher meeting last Wednesday teachers further enhanced our use of the new RE curriculum by beginning the creation of Self Assessment tasks for the students. These will be designed by Stella Maris teachers using knowledge of the new curriculum and bring with them knowledge of our learners. These Self assessment tasks will be based around the specific knowledge and learning in each Achievement Objective. The specific teaching of the Achievement Objectives may vary slightly in each class as evidence is gathered by teachers during the process of learning that may encourage an adjustment of how AO's are taught based on the learners in front of them. Self assessment is a tool to explore and assess the learning of each individual through their own eyes. Its purpose is for learners to take some control in their learning and to explore their own progress and areas for development. At each level this process varies with teacher assistance at the early levels essential and more autonomy at our senior end allowing for greater assessment of "self". Each team will use these self assessment tasks near the end of the "Our Story- A Tatou Whakapapa" theme and we hope to share these with you as your children bring their work home over the term break. This will inform our teaching and learning programmes in RE as we move forward in our implementation of the new RE curriculum.




Carmel College Pre-Enrolment Evening For Years 7 To 9 In 2025
